STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

1. There will be no use of any form of alcoholic beverages, cigarettes, smokeless tobacco, or drugs in any form unless prescribed by a physician.
2. All curfews and bed checks will be adhered to as set up by the teacher in charge.
3. Students are responsible for their conduct in regard to public property such as hotel rooms, transporting vehicles, playgrounds, hotel equipment, etc. Students will be held financially responsible for any damage that they cause.
 - Hotel rooms will be inspected by the supervisor and the occupants of each room prior to the occupying of each room and again before checkout. Any damage incurred will be the responsibility of the occupants.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Students will stay in groups when traveling or sightseeing. They **will not travel alone** or leave the group.
